

# Key Stage 1

## Barnston Primary School and National Level Data 2015

The white area of the table shows the percentage of eligible children at Barnston Primary School achieving each level, compared to national end of Key Stage 1 teacher assessment levels (48 children). The shaded sections of the table represent 2015 national teacher assessment data for core subjects.

As you can see pupils gained higher than the expected level 2c:

**91.7% gained 2b+ in reading (2016 this is the expected standard)** **L3 35.4%**

**89.6% gained 2b+ in writing** **L3 25.0%**

**91.7% gained 2b+ in maths** **L3 35.4%**

### Average Point Score

Reading 17.2, Writing 16.3 and Maths 17.2 = 16.9 overall

(where 15.9 was National Average 2014)

Figures may not total 100 per cent because of rounding (2.1% have specific educational needs).
